The information cannot be disclosed as per the order of CIC in (Manira Sharma.V, National Informatic centre, 2015 SCC online CIC 16647 decided on Dec 16, 2015) "Providing the list of all email ids in a CD format could pose a security threat as well as the risk of disruption of essential public services by making the information susceptible to misuse louses.
3.	Out of the Total E Mail accounts opened, please provide me the list of deactivated e mail account details with reasons for deactivation, as on the date of receipt of this letter, against the name, designation and present address of such Government employees.	No such information is maintained in this office as requested.
4.	A confirmation shall be provided in the form of information that all such official E mail address opened utilising the above 87.73 lakhs are available in the public domain, ie., in the respective department website.	There is no provision to disclose information under section 2 (f) of RTI Act, 2005.
